CANTRAIN Awards' Programs: The 2023-24 Application Process

CANTRAIN administered the programs with 3 other CTTPs in CAN-TAP-TALENT, CBITN and StrokeCog: <u>Studentships Fellowships Internships</u>.

149 applications have successfully navigated the portal and submission process, then transferred to reviewers from all across Canada for the next 4 weeks following evaluation grids specifically adapted to master, doctoral and post-doctoral applicants. We shall report details to profile all EDIA and other principles next month and thereafter results will be revealed in September for 82 awardees. Next year 2024-25 will be launched by **June 2024**. A better, wider process of marketing and dissemination of offers will be enabled starting January 2024.

CANTRAIN Internships' Programs: The 2023-24 Application Process

First of four internships programs. We shall launch the first one by September 1st for CRP (Clinical Research Professionals), Residents, Fellows and ECR (Early Career Investigators). The program will engage several CTTPs working together via CANTRAIN portal and therefore a number of models will be proposed:

1. Half to full day awards to protect time to access training programs and exchange with mentors from across Canadian academic/health sciences centers/institutes to enable collaboration, and exchanging information on real-world conduct of clinical trials: <u>CRP Internships</u>;

2. The second model is to enable on-site exchanges (travel in-person to participating sites) for one to four weeks practicum.

To continue to deliver on the promise of training and mentoring the next generations of CRP and Trialists, CANTRAIN will be launching an opportunity with industry for graduate and postgraduates' students for an immersive internship/practicum of 4 months and generous financial support. Launch September 22, 2024: <u>Graduate Students Internships</u>.

Second, while the demonstration project is taking place, we are devoted to the development of the level 1 of each stream what is, at the same time, exciting and challenging as a large committee including people from across Canada meets to discuss every single week: <u>wecantrain.ca/CTTP</u>.

To start with, we concluded the assessment of the demonstration project and we are using the evidence we collected to improve the Core Programming that will be launched at the end of September. At the same time, the curriculum development continues within each stream, the mentorship programs, studentship awards and more to come in the fall with the GPT Stream training, and specific for awardees and internships' Learners.

To foster a productive discussion that takes into account the comments and suggestions of the PanCanadian members who meet weekly and the subject expert from each stream, a selected team of professionals that includes the national coordinators, the content developer and designer, a clinical research educator, and the stream training national director will sit together in a retreat.
